



## Get Your Imagination Ready for a Holiday Postcard Drawing Contest!

In a community effort, the Habitat for Humanity of Taos is sponsoring a drawing contest. This contest is open to youth, ages 8 through 14, whose parents receive electrical service from any of the 16 rural electric cooperatives in New Mexico.

Judges from Habitat for Humanity of Taos will select four winners. The winners of the contest will have his or her work published in an upcoming issue of the *enchantment*. Four chosen drawings will be printed on postcards and sold by the Habitat for Humanity of Taos. First, Second, third, and fourth place entries will also receive a T-shirt.

The Habitat for Humanity of Taos is a non-profit organization that provides affordable housing for low-income families in the Taos County area. Its goal is to reduce the number of families living in substandard housing in Taos County. The Taos Habitat affiliate was incorporated in 1993 and began building its first two houses in 1994.

### Contest Theme

In the spirit of the holidays and helping needy families without homes, the contest theme is "Habitat, Home for the Holidays." The drawing may depict a home in the mountains, in a community, or in a rural area in a holiday setting. Family, friends, pets, or vehicles may also be featured as part of the drawing.

### Contest Rules

- The entrant must be the child of a parent or guardian who receives electrical service from any of the 16 New Mexico rural electric cooperatives.
- The entrant must be between the ages of 8 and 14.
- Entries must be the original work of the entrant. No professional drawings allowed.
- Drawings must be drawn on an 8x10 sheet of white paper. Ruled paper is automatically disqualified.
- Drawings must be done in either magic markers or colored pencils. Crayon or watercolor drawings are automatically disqualified.
- Each drawing must have a completed entry form accompanied with it.
- One entry per household allowed.
- Any entry received, gives New Mexico Rural Electric Cooperative Association, publisher of *enchantment*, permission from a parent or legal guardian to publish the name of the winner, age, community name, and drawing in the *enchantment* as well as on the postcards for Habitat for Humanity of Taos.

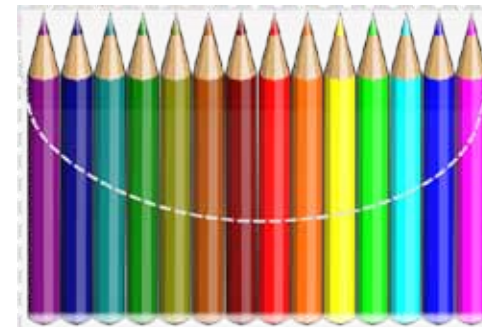
